16	Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT)	An Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) is a transaction that takes place over a computerized network, either among accounts at the same bank or to different accounts at separate financial institutions / Bank. It takes very less time in comparison to physical mode. Example – NEFT, RTGS, etc.
17	Could this eligibility criteria be broader (rather than MHUs, it could be health programme)	Refer point no. – 5 as stated above.
