- (e) Shall be of sound health, good physique and free from organic defects or bodily infirmity, and
- (f) Shall have not more than one spouse living.

2. FUNCTIONS OF A COUNSELLOR:

Counsellor entrusted with any petition shall assist and advise the parties regarding the settlement of subject-matter of dispute between the parties or any part thereof. The counsellor shall also help the parties in arriving at a reconciliation.

3. FEE OF A COUNSELLOR:

Fee of the Principal counsellor is Rs. 1125/- and that of the counsellor is Rs. 788/- per day of actual work w.e.f. 01.01.2019 as an ad-hoc arrangement in pursuance of order dtd. 07.01.2019 of the Hon'ble High Court of Orissa in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 10344 of 2011 and published vide Government of Orissa, Law Department resolution No. 1693/L dtd. 15.02.2019.
