"Grace in School" Project Launched to Strengthen Eco-Clubs in Angul

Angul, Odisha, October 2,2023 — On the eve of Gandhi Jayanti, the District Administration of Angul, in collaboration with JSP Foundation, launched the "Grace in School" project. This project's implementation partner is NITCON Social Foundation.

About the Project

The "Grace in School" project is an extension of the broader GRACE (Governmental Response for Achieving Circular Economy) program and Mission Life (Lifestyle for Environment). It aims to foster environmental stewardship among students by implementing a green curriculum in schools. The project focuses on capacity building for both teachers and club members, aiming to initiate a chain reaction of green and sustainable activities at the community level.

In its pilot phase, 250 schools have been selected out of approximately 1,400 plus total schools in Angul through a baseline survey. The project is based on five broad thematic areas: Environment, Circular Economy, WASH (Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene), Disaster Management, and Climate Change.
